A LETTER FROM THE GENERAL MANAGER

Dear Friends,

I want to thank you all for being patient as we get to the home stretch on our improvements. I am certain the end product will be an excellent representation of the new Oceanside. I say that because at the end of the day that is what will be the lasting impression – how did it look in the end? I try to keep this perspective when I consider my primary goals on this project were:

1. Complete the project within our budget
2. Complete the project with quality finishes and fixtures appropriate for a country club
3. Complete the project in early November.

I feel that we are in very good shape on the budget at this point. I also believe the finished product will stand out as a beautiful space within the Club. We have had delays from the very beginning when the planning and architectural drawings were being developed. So while I wish we had a smoother timeline, its secondary to the top two goals. Again I thank you for your patience and continued support of the Dining Room while we make the final finishing touches on the new Grill Room.

It's about time we took a look at both our lunch and dinner menus and the Chef has worked on some new items and improvements to our current options while keeping our member favorites. The lunch menu is overdue for some updates and we have several new ideas to bring you in December. Some of our new items include A Caprese Salad, Braised Short Rib Quesadilla, and a Turkey with Cranberry Aoli sandwich. We also are planning new flatbreads including a Crab Rangoon along with a Neapolitan Clam. Look for these changes in the coming month.

We also plan to revamp the dinner menu with some added standard options. Today you know these standard items as our excellent Prime NY Strip Steak, the beautifully tender Filet Mignon Steak, and Shrimp

"Your Way". We will keep those popular items and add four new standards, three entrees and one appetizer. First, we have added a favorite vegetarian dish of Chef Clint's called Roasted Vegetable Stack with Tomato Ragu. We will also have a chicken dish every week starting with Stuffed Chicken Breast with Seasonal Vegetables and Boursin Cream Sauce. Lastly we will be serving the chef's signature Braised Boneless Beef Short Ribs with Pan Gravy. These three items will be added to the original three as basic features on the menu each week. Next, again due to popular demand we have added Jumbo Shrimp Cocktail as the third appetizer. Chef Clint will then offer five additional entrees that will change weekly. Hopefully you will find this menu familiar but also unique each week. I want to also announce that because of tremendous popularity the last two times we offered 2 pound lobster dinners, it will reappear on the menu once every month. So if you miss it, you can count on seeing it again soon. Lastly we are going to have a Prime Rib Special on one Saturday each month.

I want all of our members to keep in mind you belong to a private club and we are here to serve you. If you have a favorite dish or special item you'd like to see on our menu, just let us know and we will do everything in our power to make it happen. Our new kitchen is running great and I think I can speak for everyone in our F&B department that we thank all of the members for their support in getting this project completed. It came out great and we look forward to serving you at Oceanside Country Club!

Golf Tip of the Month: "Into the Wind"

There is a common mistake made by every golfer when teeing off into the wind. We all tend to swing too hard, and tee in too low. It is a fact that the trajectory has little to do with how far a ball will travel

into the wind. The spin rate is what determines how far a ball will travel on a windy day.

The harder you swing at a ball, the more backspin you create. It is this backspin that causes the ball to land short into the wind. The best thing to do into the wind is to swing softer in order to generate less spin. It is like the old saying—"swing easy when it's breezy". You will still give up yards, but not as much.

The other cause of too much spin off the tee, in any condition, is teeing the ball up too low. When the ball is on a tee too low it causes you to hit down on it. This creates a lot of backspin which will result in what I call a riser. This is a ball that starts out low and rises. A ball should be struck slightly on the upswing with a driver. This creates the high launch/low spin effect which will result in longer drives. The thought of teeing it low into the wind causes an opposite effect then what you are trying to achieve. You will more often hit it higher. I prefer to tee it as high as possible at all times.

This is just a couple of things to think about during your next round, especially entering our windy season. We are always available to answer any questions you may have the next time you are out.

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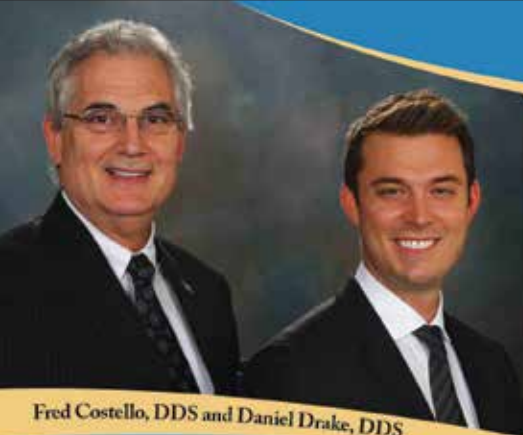
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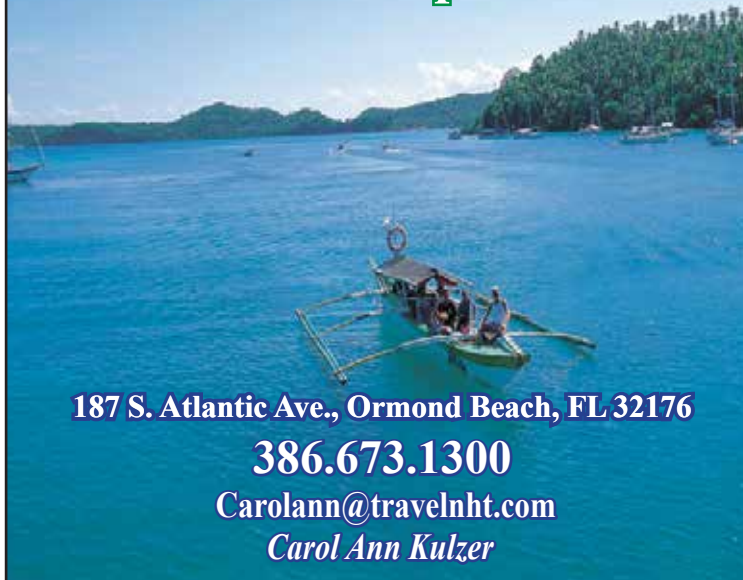
