2014 FALL INVITE TOURNAMENT FORMAT

FLIGHTS

Teams have been flighted by the Tournament Committee according to combined handicaps of the Member and his Guest. Handicaps have been adjusted to 90%. The Tournament Committee decisions are final with regard to the handicaps

COMPETITION “MATCH AROUND”

- ◆ 5 Nine Hole Matches
- ◆ Shotgun at 8:30 AM Friday (3 Matches)
- ◆ Shotgun at 8:30 AM Saturday (2 Matches)

Better ball of partners' match play, played at difference in handicap off the lowest handicapped player. If a particular flight has less than 6 teams, each team will play a 9 hole match verses par.

SCORING

Points are earned within each nine hole match as follows (match totals):

1up=2.0pts.	1down= -1.0pts.
2up=2.1	2down= -1.1
3up=2.2	3down= -1.2
4up=2.3	4down= -1.3
5up or more=2.4	5down= -1.4
Tie=1.0	

*****Every hole must be played in each match*****

-In case of inclement weather or raining out of matches, the golf professional staff will make the determination of how many matches will be played in a particular flight to decide the winning team.

-If a team “No Shows,” the match is forfeited once it proceeds to the 3rd tee. The team scheduled to play the forfeiting team receives 2.0 points as well as all other teams that play this team.

THE FALL INVITE RULES OF PLAY

U.S.G.A. rules will govern except where modified by the following local rules:

1. Out of Bounds - defined by white stakes and the wall to the right of hole #1.
2. All Water Hazards - defined by red stakes or lines
3. Ground Under Repair - encircled in white
4. Embedded Ball - ball may be lifted “through the green” (Fairway and rough) from its own pitch mark, cleaned and dropped, without penalty as near as possible to the spot where it lay, but no closer to the hole
5. Suspension of Play - temporary suspension of play due to inclement weather will be signaled by one prolonged blast on the golf course sirens.
6. Attest All Scorecards - for each match, scorecards must be signed and attested by one team member from each team. Please return the cards to the scoreboard as soon as possible after completion of the match.

LOCAL RULES

- ◆ The ball shall be played as it lies
- ◆ Late to the Tee - A player may represent the side
- ◆ “14 Club Rule” applies
- ◆ For pace of play purposes, please play “Ready Golf” in all matches.
- ◆ No more than 2 hours per 9. Keep up with the group in front of you.

DETERMINATION OF WINNERS

Flight winners - cumulative points of all five (or possibly less) matches played will determine winners.

In case of flight tie- playoff will be played with tournament handicap, difference in handicap off the lowest handicapped player on #1 (better ball of partners). If #1 is tied, a “chip off” will determine the flight winner, closest to the hole, best shot of the team.

Overall winner - each of the flight winners will compete in a grand 3 hole playoff starting at tee #1 around 1:30 pm.

2nd Place Point Winner- The TWO teams that earn the most points and doesn't win their flight also qualifies for the “Grand Playoff”. If there is a tie for this position a blind chip off at the North Putting Green will commence immediately after the points have been totaled. The chip off format will be total distance from the hole by each 2 player team, closest wins.

Playoff format: Using tournament handicap all the flight winning teams and the two “2nd place point winners” will tee off on #1. The team score is the cumulative score of the 2 players over the 3 holes. Hole rotation is #1, #7, & #9. After #1 the low 6 teams continue, after #7 the low 3 teams continue. If there is a tie for 6th or 3rd there will be a blind “chip off”. Total distance from the hole of the 2 player team, closest wins. The playoff format will be adjusted if necessary due to inclement weather.
