## A LETTER FROM THE GENERAL MANAGER



Dear Friends,

We are now in the midst of summer and for some reason, a hostile weather pattern. I played the course in early June and you can easily see from the areas we don't irrigate that there has been almost no rain for the month of May or June. Normally we would expect the rainy season to begin and afternoon showers to help us keep the green plants green. As of mid-June we have had a couple days of rain but not nearly enough. We do have an aging infrastructure in the golf course irrigation system which is currently 23 years old. The life expectancy of this equipment is 25 to 30 years and I can tell you Danny has made many improvements over the years. These include the pump station and controller replacement last year along with many years of adding heads and expanding the coverage. Still it is not enough during a drought and during these dry days the irrigation system weakness shows. We have this particular issue on our radar and we are planning accordingly to address it. So I encourage you to be patient as we all wait for more rain.

We have received the results and comments from the survey and that information will be forthcoming to the general membership. Currently we are preparing a presentation for the Board and using the information to formulate strategies and direction for the Club as a whole. We received great feedback on the club in all areas. The results were very positive overall and satisfaction was very high. However I am certain that all areas can improve and we will use the results to work toward that goal. Each month I will try to address one or more of the concerns mentioned in the survey.

I would like to begin by addressing menu variety and hopefully help the members understand why we are where we are and what we can do to further improve the operation. It was a little perplexing from my standpoint as just before the survey went out we made substantial changes to both the lunch and dinner menu. But this is the perception, and I know that perception is reality. We practice a fairly unique idea for a country club dinner menu that is time consuming and relatively diffi-

cult to pull off week after week. That practice is to change eight items on the menu every week so that we can present a variety of fresh seafood and different proteins. The intent is to keep the menu from getting boring. When I started the existing menu was static and saw relatively few changes. I initiated a new system where we shortened the menu but changed everything every week. That evolved into keeping certain items as "regulars" so that members could depend on a favorite entrée every time they came in. The regular list grew from three items to include six items covering steaks, shrimp, pasta, chicken, and a vegetarian dish. We also created two new appetizers each week and a feature dinner salad. So in all we create for the menu five entrees, two appetizers and one salad feature every week. Then we changed some of our guidelines again and added a whole lobster special that runs every other month and a Prime Rib special that runs once per month.

It certainly feels like we have variety there but now I think we are challenged to evolve again. Our plans to address the concern for more variety will include changing some of the items on the "standard" list for new things – a different chicken dish, a new vegetarian dish and possibly some other type of pasta dish. We are looking at changing the lunch menu again but also trying to expand to include some shareable appetizers. We always try to make sure we don't change the things that are popular or items that are part of the OCC tradition. So we will adjust carefully and please keep letting us know how we are doing.

### Golfer Tip of the Month: Golf Course Etiquette

It is always a good thing to be reminded on golf course etiquette. Here are some basic guidelines that the USGA puts out.

#### *The Spirit of the Game*

*Unlike many sports, golf is played, for the most part, without supervision of a referee or umpire. The game relies on the integrity of the individual to show consideration for other players and to abide by the rules. All players should conduct themselves in a disciplined manner, demonstrating courtesy and sportsmanship at all times, irrespective of how competitive they may be. This is the spirit of the game.*

#### Safety

- Be aware of your surroundings. Make sure no one is close enough to be struck by your club, ball, or anything else that might come loose during a stroke or practice swing.
- Do not play a shot until the group ahead is out of range.
- If you hit a shot offline and there is a danger of hitting someone, you should immediately shout a warning. The traditional warning in this situation is "fore"

#### Consideration of others

- Players should always show consideration for others by not moving, talking or making any unnecessary noise while others are playing a shot.
- On the putting green you should never stand on another player's line, or cast a shadow over their ball.

#### Pace of Play

- It is a group's responsibility to keep up with the group in front. If it loses a clear hole and it is delaying the group behind, it should invite the group behind to play through, irrespective of the number of players in that group.
- You should be ready to play when it is your turn. Finding your yardage and selecting a club should be done while others are playing. Also, you should read your putts on the green while other are putting. This will all save time in the end.

#### Care of the course

- Before leaving a bunker you should rake all footprints and holes you created while playing.
- You need to repair all ball marks on the green and sand all divots.
- It is every player's responsibility to try and prevent any unnecessary damage while playing.

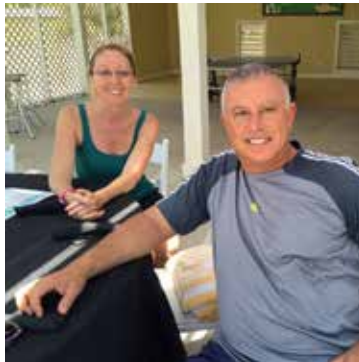
